

Girl Scout & Boy Scout Badge Programs

As with all Inward Bound experiences, these badge programs ensure the highest level of quality equestrian education. Scouts will learn the proper way to groom and care for horses, thus setting the stage for potential employment at any major riding facility. All riding programs provide safety education and classical instruction at a pace equal to the level of each individual. Each step of every program is focused on mastering the quality of the task or movement prior to introducing more advanced skills. Competencies are verbally tested throughout each class to ensure a thorough understanding of the material and a high level of retention has been achieved.

- **Horse Lover Badge-** Three hour program developed to cover all areas described in the scout handbook under badge requirements.
 - <3 scouts: \$45 per person (requires 1 adult to supervise)
 - 4-6 scouts: \$35 per person (requires 2 adults to supervise)
 - 7-9 scouts: \$25 per person (requires 3 adults to supervise)

 - **Horse Rider Badge *-** Four two hour customized classes designed to meet the scouts at their current experience level and to provide relevant horsemanship education that assists them to becoming competent horsemen/horsewomen.
 - Each class will be limited to 3 riders who are at the same skill level.
 - All four classes must be taken within 8 weeks of registration.
 - \$50 per class per scout (\$200 each for total program)
 - Parents and scout leaders are welcome to observe all classes.
- * Some riding experience is necessary prior to enrolling in this course.
